Here are some suggestions about how to pray for this Sunday's ministry:

- Pray for Gavin preaching on Philippians 1 and John Khnana preaching on
 1 Corinthians 2 in the morning and for Matt on Ephesians 5 in the evening. Pray that the
 ascended Lord would speak powerfully through these servants so that His will is done in our
 lives.
- 2. Many people are very fatigued as the lockdown continues. Pray for every aspect of our services, including the prayers and the music to be a great encouragement to us all. Pray that the promise of the ascended Jesus to the weary in Matthew 11:28-30 would be answered.
- 3. Please especially remember our many families and the great work that is being done by Cara and Hannah with the children and Simon with Centrepoint and Contact. Amid all the pressures that families are facing with home schooling and working from home, pray that Sundays would



be different and would provide more focussed opportunities for encountering the ascended Lord Jesus together.

The prayer is the Collect for the Sunday after Ascension, which includes a petition that God would send the Spirit to strengthen us:

O God the King of glory, you have exalted your only Son Jesus Christ with great triumph to your kingdom in heaven: we beseech you, leave us not comfortless, but send your Holy Spirit to strengthen us and exalt us to the place where our Saviour Christ is gone before, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.
