Why should I give?

Part of our family responsibility is to invest the resources He gives us for His purposes and for His glory.

In the Bible, God calls us to respond to Him in thankfulness by giving to and through our local church where we are fed and nurtured.

We are asked to give liberally, joyfully, generously and freely, and in proportion to our ability.

But since you excel in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness and in the love we have kindled in you—see that you also excel in this grace of giving.

What do we need?

For the Mission Fund the estimated value of grants to our missionaries is £212,000.

For the General Fund our projected expenditure is £1,303,000 to cover our 7-day a week ministry and outreach. If you are giving to St Nicholas, please do review your giving and consider how much more you can give. If you are not yet giving to St Nicholas, please consider if you can start supporting the gospel work we do at St Nicholas Church.

The Crisis Fund demonstrates practical love through a gift of money to those suffering as a result of an adversity, where there is a connection (either personal or via a relevant organisation) to St Nicholas Church, Sevenoaks.

How should I give?

- Regular giving by cash, cheque or standing order.
- One off donations from bonuses, gifts, inheritances and legacies.
- If you are a tax payer, please maximise your giving by allowing us to reclaim Gift Aid of 25p per £1 with no additional cost to you.

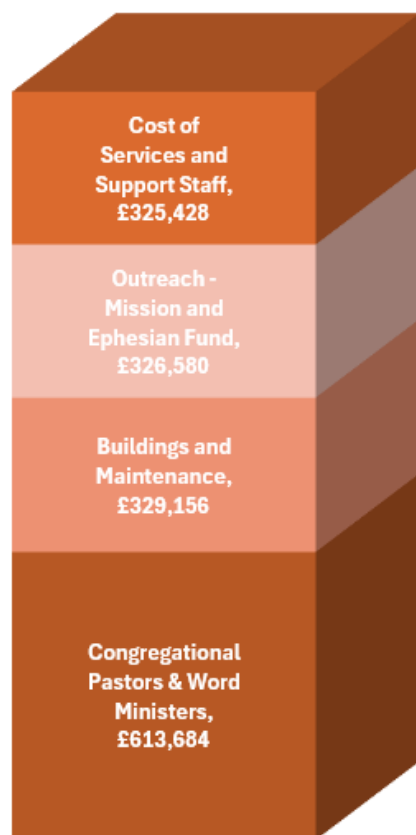

Please therefore could all UK taxpayers complete and return a new Gift Aid Declaration even if nothing has changed. Please ensure you will be paying sufficient tax to cover the gift aid being claimed against your name.
